Suggested wording for your will:

"I give the sum of £__ (pounds only) free of all taxes to Emmanuel International Ltd and I declare that the receipt from the office shall be a sufficient discharge to my executors and trustees."

If you already have a will, you can attach a simple codicil form to it. A codicil is a document used to make simple amendments to your existing will such as adding a charity, changing a gift amount or adding an executor.

We strongly advise you see a solicitor when writing or amending your will.
