A Night of Celebration and Impact

We have raised approximately \$60,000 net for the project. This generosity has made a huge impact already.

A Shared Mission: Titukule Azimai (Empower Women)

The night would not be the same without the exquisite meal prepared by Award winning Chef Donald Williams. Many commented on the great meal especially the Pumkin Salad!

Ben Voss, Programs Manager for Emmanuel International Malawi, and Joella Reitsma, Grants Manager, took us on a journey of understanding the challenges and opportunities in Malawi throught the new "Titukule Azimai" project, which means "Empower Women" in Chichewa, funded through Global Affairs Canada and Emmanuel International Canada.

A Journey to Uganda and Malawi

Ben and Joella detailed the project's origins, development, and objectives in a presentation that highlighted the innovative approaches taken to tackle gender-based violence (GBV) and economic vulnerability in Malawi. They explained how community-led solutions are driving real change, from establishing Village Savings and Loans groups (VSLs) for economic security to creating safe spaces for women to voice

To open the evening prior to our Guest speakers, Bobby Wong shared his reflections of his recent trip to Uganda. Greeting the Audience with



their challenges and make meaningful changes within their communities.

With vivid stories and photos, Joella shared her reflections on visiting Malawi for the first time and seeing the stark differences in daily life between Malawi and Canada. Yet, despite these differences, what stood out was the unwavering spirit and warmth of the Malawian people. She recounted meeting incredible women whose lives were transformed through new skills, economic independence, and community support provided by VSL groups.

Tackling Root Causes and Building Solutions

Ben and Joella also emphasized the importance of addressing the root causes of gender-based violence. They introduced the STAR approach (Situation, Task, Action, Result), a methodology empowering women and community members to identify and solve challenges collectively. The project's initiatives focus not only on economic empowerment but also on transforming perceptions and improving services for survivors of GBV, ensuring lasting change and systemic support.

The presentations served as a powerful reminder of the importance of grassroots

collaboration and the impact of understanding the needs of a community from their perspective. The gala attendees were invited to visualize life in Malawi through stories of resilience, a glimpse into daily life, and the vibrant culture of the "Warm Heart of Africa."

A Message of Hope and Gratitude

The evening concluded with a closing video introducing the dedicated team members in Malawi, including the Country Director, Charles, who recently accepted an award on behalf of Emmanuel International Malawi at the President of Malawi's Gala Dinner. Joella and Ben expressed their gratitude to all in attendance for their unwavering support, emphasizing how every bit of contribution and encouragement helps change lives.

Ben concluded with a heartfelt message: "We want to again thank you all for taking the time to be here tonight and show your support for not just these projects, but the many missionaries and various initiatives around the world. Every bit of support is helping change lives for now and eternity."
