

Community Development Missionary, Iringa, Mwanza, or Handeni, Tanzania

Background

Emmanuel International Tanzania (EITZ) has been working in partnership with the Anglican Diocese of Ruaha (DR) and the Pentecostal Holiness Mission (PHM) in Iringa, and the Tanzania Assemblies of God (TAG) in Mwanza and Tanga for many years, assisting these churches with physical and spiritual development projects. Over the years EITZ has received missionaries with various backgrounds. These can include but are not limited to; agriculture, livestock, healthcare, teaching, pastoring, counseling, entrepreneurship, community development, engineering.

Responsibilities

A community development missionary would have defined responsibility based on his/her abilities and project however general responsibilities would include:

- Communication and working with church leaders
- Building capacity in the local team of staff
- Sharing in local churches
- Project Management

Duration

Preferably two or more years

Requirements

The candidate should have a degree or higher diploma (note that this is a requirement to obtain a residence permit for Tanzania). The candidate should have excellent people skills and be a good communicator. A committed Christian faith is essential. A driving license is desirable. Please note adaptability is essential in cross-

cultural development work. EITZ considers the following personal qualities to be just as important as formal qualifications and experience: flexibility, humility, servant heartedness, and willingness to learn. EITZ staff live and work alongside local people and value this serving relationship.
